From the Treasurer

Our financial position, at the end of August 2009, is not looking very rosy – in fact it is downright dismal. Our revenue from all sources averages at 55% of budgeted projection. Most sources are at projected levels, some such as fund raisers are ahead of schedule, but our weekly givings are falling far short of our actual needs. Our expenses are running at projected budget amounts.

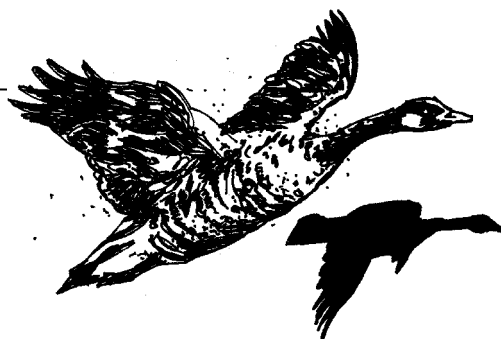
14th Arrowsmith Cub Scouts
